# Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board

- The Board is composed of 7 members; 5 pharmacists and 2 public
- Members are appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the State Senate
- Four year terms: may serve two consecutive terms
- Responsible for administering and enforcing pharmacy laws and administrative rules

# PEB Responsibilities – Protecting WI Citizens

- Licensing pharmacists, pharmacies, manufacturers and distributors of prescription drugs
- Adopting administrative rules
- Investigating violations of laws under its jurisdiction
- Taking disciplinary action against its licensees
- Writing and reviewing MPJE questions for NABP

# Controlled Substance Issues

- C-II's what can be changed via consultation with the prescriber?
  - Everything but the Patient, Drug, Prescriber, and Fill on/after date
  - When can you fax a C-II?
    - Patients who are in a LTC facility or are enrolled in Hospice (Must be stated on Rx for hospice)
  - Emergency Fill of C-II?
    - Reduced to writing followed by hardcopy within 7 days
    - 72 hour supply, and no other alternative is available
  - Can you partial fill a C-II?
    - Must dispense the remainder of the fill within 72 hours
  - When can C-II be received via e-script?

# FAQs – E-Prescribing

- DEA published rules for e-prescribing of controlled substances on June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.
- Require all vendors to be certified in order to transmit, receive, or exchange electronic prescriptions.
- WI law now allows for this when compliant with Federal Law

# Controlled Substances

- Drugs that are controlled in WI but not federally
  - Testosterone in it's estrogen combination product
  - Pseudoephedrine
- What drug recently changed to controlled status?
  - Carisoprodol
- Note: Tramadol is not controlled but is reported to the PDMP.

# Duty to Dispense Contraceptives

- Dispensing Items of Ethical Judgment
  - Plan B
  - Oral Contraceptives
  - Contraceptive Devices
- Without Delay – the normal time it takes to fill a prescription.
- Must fill unless the Rx is errant, fraudulent, or is contraindicated

# Expedited Partner Therapy

- Pharmacist and pharmacies do not have to participate
- Treatment of trichomoniasis, gonorrhea, and chlamydia trachomatis
- May fill a Rx for Abx treatment of the above for an unnamed patient
- Must write separate prescriptions (HIPPA)
- Must provide counseling and check for allergies
- Protected from civil liability through statute

# Vaccinations

- Pharmacists and interns must complete training
  - PSW or APhA training is available
- Carry Liability Insurance
- Pharmacist with unrestricted lic. can vaccinate down to age 6.
- Interns and Pharmacists who must be supervised can vaccinate down to age 18

# Remote Dispensing Sites

- Pharmacy and Pharmacist
  - This is not a Licensed Pharmacy, it is an extension of an already existing pharmacy
  - Must be placed in a health care facility
  - Must have a managing pharmacist and supervising pharmacy, this information is displayed at remote site
  - Rx's have supervising pharmacy info on them and pharmacist is required to talk to patient each time
  - Remote site can not be open when supporting pharmacy is closed

# Remote Dispensing Sites

- Technicians and Interns
  - Must be 18 years of age
  - Must be high school graduate or equivalent
  - Must have completed 1500 hours of work as a technician in the 3 years prior to being hired or complete a training program approved by the board



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

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# Faxing Rx Transfers

- Always takes place between two pharmacists
- Faxed information is allowed
- Must be confirmed by the parties involved to ensure that transfer is completed.
  
- Transferring pharmacist must respond to requests from receiving pharmacist after the fax is completed

# Retiring / Moving / Deceased Providers


- Must have a physician – patient – pharmacist relationship
- If a physician retires, the relationship is broken
- If a physician moves out of the area, the relationship is broken
  - Future refills are invalid when this occurs.
- Remember to always be mindful of the patient's welfare in these situations

- Rules Processes initiated by acceptance of Harold Rogers Prescription Drug Monitoring Implementation Grand – 10/01/11
- *Veterinarians are NOT Required to report (Farm Bill)*
- *Data Collection Begins – 1/1/13*
- *Date Submissions – 4/1/13*
- *Retro Data Collection Complete – 4/29/13*
- *Query Site Operational – 6/1/13*
